# CAMPAIGN '11 OVERVIEW

**Thank you for your desire to attend the 2011 Campaign in Hattiesburg, MS as a student! Please read carefully this packet of information before submitting your application form and payment.**

The main emphasis of this campaign is evangelism. We will knock doors in Hattiesburg inviting residents to worship/Gospel Meeting (preached by David Shannon). We will also encourage them to sign-up for Bible Correspondence Courses. We are concerned about lost souls no matter where they live. We are praying they come to the Lord through this effort. We are also praying that all participants from Midway will grow as soul-winners in their daily walk with the Lord.

The secondary emphasis of this campaign is group/team building and fellowship. The challenge we're accepting will test us as individuals, but accepting it as a group will build us stronger. We are praying this campaign builds a group of students and adults who depend more upon one another. We are also praying this campaign creates and strengthens Christian relationships with students and adults from Birmingham, Mt. Juliet, and Hattiesburg.

**Campaign Dates:** June 17-24

**Tentative Schedule:**

- Depart Jasper - *Friday June 17th* (around or after lunch)
- Knock Doors/Attend Gospel Meeting services - *Saturday June 18th-Wednesday June 22nd*
- Depart for New Orleans - *Thursday June 23rd* (early AM; spend all day & Fri AM in NOLA)
- Depart for home - *Friday June 24th* (around lunch; should arrive home between 8-10pm)

**Student Participants:**

- Must be in 7th-12th grades (upcoming school year; and recently graduated Seniors)
- Must be baptized, New Testament Christians (or willing to study with Minister/Elder)
- Must attend training sessions during Wed. PM Bible Classes in month of May (4th, 11th, 18th, 25th)
- Must be members at Midway OR be approved by elders (Midway students have first priority) and pay/raise support to cover hotel costs for Friday-Wednesday nights.

**Costs:**

- Midway pays for hotel costs for nights of door-knocking (Fri. thru Wed. = 6 nights); the Kensington Woods congregation provides meals for Saturday thru Wednesday.
- Participant fees (likely **\$75/person**) cover Thurs PM's hotel and other entertainment expenses related to the New Orleans visit (likely 1 banquet/catered meal, swamp tour, etc.).
- Participants will also be responsible for 6-7 meals during travel and free time. Most--if not all--will be fast-food variety.
- Participants will need to bring *additional* money if interested in purchasing Hattiesburg/USM/New Orleans souvenirs and/or additional entertainment in New Orleans (ie, Aquarium, Zoo).

*We will do our best to ensure everyone who submits an application packet participates in the Campaign. Depending on several variables, however, we may have to cap the number of participants. To help us make arrangements for as many as possible, please submit this packet and a deposit of \$15/person or \$25/family by the 2nd week of May.*



# STUDENT EXPECTATIONS

As a student participant on the Campaign, I agree to the following expectations:

- I agree to attend all training, planning, and prayer sessions leading up to the Campaign. These include: every Wednesday night Bible Class in May (**4th, 11th, 18th, 25th**), prayer meetings before/after worship services, and a Saturday prayer meeting on **June 11th**. I understand that I will be assigned make-up work for missing any session and absences may eliminate me from attending the Campaign.
- I agree to participate in all group activities during the Campaign. I understand I am responsible for staying with adult chaperones throughout the campaign.
- I agree to show the utmost respect to all adult chaperones and volunteers from every congregation present on the Campaign. I will obey them with kindness. I will accept door-knocking group & riding assignment(s) without questioning or complaining.
- I will treat all fellow student participants with kindness and respect in every situation.
- I agree to abide by the dress code set forth by the Kensington Woods congregation:
  - Pants during all door-knocking sessions
  - If wearing a t-shirt during door-knocking sessions, only wear "church" related shirts (Midway, Exposure, camp, etc.); obviously, you can wear shirts nicer than a t-shirt as well
  - "Sunday night" attire during nightly Gospel Meeting sessions (will return to hotel daily to change)
  - Sunday AM attire (ties for boys, dresses/skirts for girls) on Sunday's services.
  - (*I will also refrain from tank tops/sleeveless shirts at all times and will avoid flip-flops during church services.*)
- I agree to avoid hotel rooms of members of the opposite sex unless an adult chaperone is *present in the room with us*. I will be in my room at curfew and will not leave it after curfew/lights out.
- I will not bring drugs, alcohol, tobacco/cigarettes, pornography, weapons (guns, knives, explosives) or any other "illicit" material.
- I will limit my time on my cell phone/mp3 player to travel days and the hotel room. I don't want to interfere with the evangelistic purposes and group-building opportunities the Campaign provides.
- Above all, I will elevate the good of the group and our evangelistic efforts above how I feel and what I want. I realize I will be tired, sleepy, and exhausted; but I will still exemplify a Christlike attitude in all things.

*To be read & completed by parent or legal guardian:*

- Though this is a trip with minimal risks (heat, interacting with the community, riding in vehicles, etc), there is potential for accidents, emergencies, sickness, and injuries.
